

In addition, you can monitor your fire alarm with a monitored fire alarm, so that the alarm is raised and action is taken even when no one is around.

Fire Doors

Fire compartmentation is the use of physical structures in your building to limit or slow the spread of fire. Fire doors, therefore, are a crucial part of this, blocking flames and smoke when closed and ensuring they protect evacuation routes long enough for people to escape safely.
